

2009 94th Southwestern Amateur Tournament Summary



The 94th Southwestern Amateur was held June 16-19, 2009 on the Catalina Course set as 7135 yard par-72 at OMNI Tucson National Golf Resort in Tucson, Arizona with a field of some 122 players. Travis Woolf of Fort Worth, TX, maintained his overnight lead and shot a steady 70 (-2) to shoot 72-71-65-70-278 (-10). For details check our website at <http://www.swga.net/>.

Round 1 – June 16

The first round was played under hot (92-97F) sunny skies but blustery afternoon winds (SW 15-25 mph with 30 mph gusts). 34 players shot 74 or better in the morning round while 32 players bested 74 in the afternoon. Low rounds of the day belonged to David McDaniel of Tucson, AZ, with a 66 (-6) and Blake Brown of Mesa, AZ, and George Gandranata of Emeryville, CA, with scores of 67 (-5).

Round 2 – June 17

The second round has now been completed in the 94th Southwestern Amateur being held on the Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Resort in Tucson, Arizona. Played under hot (91-94F) sunny skies but blustery afternoon winds (SW 15-25 mph with 30 mph gusts), the field has been cut to the top 60 and ties. 62 players made this cut with a 36-hole score of 148 (+4) or better. Blake Brown of Mesa, AZ, is our leader at 137 (-7). Tied for 2nd are Ryan Brooks also of Mesa, AZ, John Catlin of Carmichael, CA, and Tucson's David McDaniel with scores of 139 (-5). Low rounds of the day belonged to Brett Spencer of Plano, TX, with a 66 (-6), David Holmes of Knoxville, TN, with a 67 (-5) and Ryan Brooks of Mesa, AZ, Samuel Ewing of Lubbock, TX, Nicholas Losole III and Braxton Marquez both of Scottsdale, AZ, with 68's (-4) that helped move these players up the leader board and into the 3rd round.

Round 3 – June 18

The third [round](#) has now been completed in the 94th Southwestern Amateur being held on the Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Resort in Tucson, Arizona. Played under hot (96F) partly cloudy skies, the field has been cut again to the top 30 and ties. 31 players made this cut with a 54-hole score of 217 (+1) or better. Travis Woolf of Fort Worth, TX, jumped into the lead after shooting the low round of the day, 65 (-7), for a 54-hole total of 208 (-8). Tied for 2nd place are Blake Brown of Mesa, AZ, and John Catlin of Carmichael, CA, at 209 (-7). Other low rounds of the day belonged to Zahkai Brown of Arvada, CO, with a 67 (-5) and Michael Jensen of Los Altos, CA, with a 68 (-4) that helped move these players high up the leader board and into the final round.

Round 4 – June 19

The final [round](#) has now been completed at the 94th Southwestern Amateur held on the Catalina Course at the OMNI Tucson National Golf Resort in Tucson, Arizona, played under cloudy skies and some light afternoon rain. Travis Woolf of Fort Worth, TX, maintained his overnight lead and shot a steady 70 (-2) to shoot 72-71-65-70-278 (-10) and prevail by one shot over runner-up Michael Jensen of Los Altos, CA. "Last night, I tried not to think too much about the lead and tried to relax at dinner at Bob's with my girlfriend and mother and then to the spa for a little bit", said Travis. "I put a new putter in the bag this week and did not look at the scoreboard all week until the last green. It was a good week." This is the fourth year Travis has played in the Southwestern Amateur and plans to defend next year upon completion of his senior year at TCU. Michael Jensen in the next to the last group had a chance to tie but ended up bogeying the 18th hole. Ryan Brooks of Mesa, AZ, and David McDaniel of Tucson, AZ, finish third at 281 (-7).
