


2013 98th Southwestern Amateur Tournament Summary

The 98th Southwestern Amateur was held June 18-21, 2013 at the par 70, 7232 yard Renegade Course at the Desert Mountain Club in Scottsdale, Arizona. This year a different approach was made to improve the quality of the field. Invitation letters were sent out before Christmas to the college coaches of the top 150 collegiate players as ranked by *Golfweek*, the top 18 finishers from last year's event and the top five players of NCAA Divisions I, II & III, NAIA Divisions I & II, and NJC Divisions I & II. To entice players, host housing was offered and Desert Mountain agreed to allow players who failed to make the cut the opportunity to play one of its other opened courses on Thursday and Friday. While the response was small, our winner came from this group and most of the top fifteen finishers took advantage of hosted housing. Our winner from North Carolina said, "When I received the invitation, I researched the tournament on the website, found it to be a prestigious event, had never been to Arizona and decided to enter". Even though we had some late cancellations, we had sufficient players on a waiting list to start the tournament with a full field of 144 players. They represented 3 countries, 25 states, 84 universities & colleges, 3 community colleges and 4 high schools. Real-time scoring was used again this year.



J.T. Poston of Hickory, North Carolina, made his first visit to the deserts of Arizona a good one in capturing the 98th Southwestern Amateur just completed at Desert Mountain Club's Renegade Course. J.T., a junior-to-be at Western Carolina, jumped six places by firing a 65 (-5) to finish at 276 (-4), two shots clear of defending champion Kevin Dougherty (left) of Murrieta, California, and Max Mcgreevy (right) of Edmond, Oklahoma. Said J.T, "I felt good coming into today. I had lots of birdies yesterday but made some dumb bogeys. Today my warm-up was good and I had five birdies and no bogeys." Did he enjoy the desert? Round 1 Results - June 18

Ryan Mulvany of Reno, Nevada, took advantage of one of the earliest tee times and shot 66 (-4) to take the first round lead. Tied for second are local players Jimmy Kozikowski and Michael Anderson who are one shot back at 67 (-3). They also came out of the morning wave where there were near perfect conditions - pleasant temperatures and light winds.

The second round resumes at 7:30am tomorrow. Upon completion of play, the field will be cut to those players with the lowest sixty scores and ties.

Round 2 Results - June 19

Cole Ogden of West Point, Utah, moved into a first place tie with local player Jimmy Kozikowski at 138 (-2) at the midway point of the 98th Southwestern Amateur Golf Tournament. Ryan Mulvany of Reno, Nevada, slipped to third place one shot back. Desert Mountain Club's Renegade Course was the winner today even though weather conditions, although hot, were benign. Just four players managed to brake par. Max Mcgreevy of Edmond, Oklahoma, had the low round of the day, shooting 67 (-3) from an afternoon tee time, improving his position 37 spots to tie for sixth place.


The cut was made at 149 (+9). Exactly sixty players move on to the third and fourth rounds Thursday and Friday mornings.

Round 3 Results - June 20

Max Mcgreevy of Edmond, Oklahoma, follows his three under par 67 yesterday with an outstanding 65 (-5) for a three day total of 206 (-4) to take a three shot lead into the final round. Andrew Cornella of Colorado Springs, Colorado shot 66 (-4) to join local player Jimmy Kozikowski and Ryan Mulvany of Reno, Nevada, in a tie for second place at 209 (-1). Brian Campbell of Irvine, California, fired the low round of the day, 64 (-6), to move up twenty-four spots to fifth place.

The final round will start at 7:30 am tomorrow. Twenty-four players are within eight shots of the leader

Final Round - June 21



Max Mcgreevy of Edmond, Oklahoma, extended his lead to five shots well into the back nine before succumbing to the 236 yard par 3 14th hole in giving up six shots to par. This suddenly propelled Kevin Dougherty of Murrieta, California, and J.T. Poston of Hickory, North Carolina, who were playing together two groups ahead of Mcgreevy into a battle for the lead. Both would fire two of the best rounds of the day. Through 15 Poston was three under for the day to Dougherty's one under, giving Poston a three shot overall lead with three to play. Dougherty birdied that last three holes but it wasn't enough. Poston (center) added two birdies to shoot 65 (-5) to finish at 276 (-4), two shots clear of Dougherty (left) and Mcgreevy (right), who finished with two birdies after the disaster at 14.

The eleven players who finished in the top 10 and ties have exempt status into the 99th Southwestern Amateur which will return to the Desert Mountain Club next year.
